### What Is MOAA?

The Military Officers Association of America was founded in 1929 and is headquartered in Alexandria, VA. Over 370,000 members make it the country's largest and most influential military officers organization. Year after year, MOAA successfully defends the interests of all military personnel and advances their cause within DOD and on Capitol Hill to provide resources that serve the needs of officers and their families.

### What has MOAA Accomplished Recently?

- Became the driving force behind TRICARE for Life
- Won major survivor benefit upgrades for deaths on active Guard/Reserve duty
- Established statutory protection for commissary benefit
- Spearheaded the campaign to end SBP "Widows Tax"
- Won permanent health coverage for all drilling Guard/Reserve members and families

### Who Is Eligible To Join?

Any person commissioned by the uniformed services or the National Guard/Reserve, or any other reserve components of the services is eligible. This includes active, retired and former officers.

### Wichita Chapter

The Wichita Chapter was organized in 1959 and affiliated with the national office of MOAA that same year. Today, more than 200 members in South Central Kansas belong to the Chapter.

### Kansas Council of Chapters

The Wichita Chapter assisted in the formation of the Kansas Council of Chapters in 1974. The Council allows MOAA chapters in Topeka, Lawrence, Leavenworth, Kansas City and other Kansas localities to coordinate their efforts in pursuit of common MOAA objectives.
